BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PRESS RELEASE

The Klamath County Board of Commissioners are taking applications for the following boards / commissions / committees with upcoming vacancies.

Planning Commission - 3 positions

The Planning Commission advises the Board of Commissioners on policy level issues such as amendments to the Land Development Code or Comprehensive Plan, reviews and makes decisions on higher level land use applications such as zone changes, subdivisions and power generating facilities. The Planning Commission meets at 6:00 PM on the fourth Tuesday of each month.

Fair Board - 2 positions

Fair Board position – To serve on the Board as a voting member; develop policies, procedures and regulations for the operation of the Fairgrounds/Event Center facility and annual Fair; to monitor finances of the organization and its programs and performance; and to uphold the Oregon Revised Statutes, Chapter 565. Fair Board meetings are third Wednesday of each month at 4:00 PM.

Economic Development Advisory Committee – 2 positions

The Economic Development Advisory Committee (EDAC) will consider and recommend to the Board of Commissioners economic development contracts based on the evaluation of applications submitted by individuals and/or organizations for projects that promote economic development in Klamath County as defined by ORS 461.540. The EDAC may also consult and advise the Klamath County Board of Commissioners on economic development issues as requested by the Board of Commissioners. The time commitment is typically 20 hours over a two-month period in July and August. Additional meetings may be scheduled throughout the year.

Budget Committee - 1 position

The Budget Committee (BC) assists the Board of Commissioners in fulfilling Klamath County's obligations under Oregon Budget law. (ORS 294.305 to 294.565) The time commitment is typically 40 to 80 hours over a two-week period in April. Additional training or work sessions may be scheduled throughout the year.
