The Klamath County Board of Commissioners in conjunction with the Blue Zones Project Food Systems Advisory Committee are creating a new council, Klamath County Food Policy Council, to advise the Klamath County Board of Commissioners on food and agricultural systems issues related to food. This Council is being formed with a goal of creating a community that has consistent, encouraged access to healthy and affordable local food and whose community members have the necessary education and knowledge to be able to prepare and consume healthier food choices.

“Our food system is a key part of the overall health of our community. This is an opportunity to get more input on ways we can affect positive change on a policy level” said Commissioner Morris.
