Klamath County to Celebrate National County Government Month

Klamath County will celebrate National County Government Month (NCGM) during the month of April to showcase how the county is building a safe and secure community by managing justice systems, bolstering economic opportunities, responding to natural disasters and facilitating emergency management response. The theme for this year's celebration of NCGM is "Safe and Secure Counties."

"Klamath County is proud of the programs and services provided to our residents," said Board Chair Kelley Minty Morris. "Our efforts combined with efforts of counties across the country help keep American communities safe and secure. I encourage all county residents to take advantage of National County Government Month to learn how the county can assist you and your loved ones."

Since 1991 the National Association of Counties (NACo) has encouraged counties across the country to raise public awareness and understanding about the roles and responsibilities of counties.
