Shall Klamath Falls City Schools repair and improve schools by issuing \$36,000,000 in bonds? If the bonds are approved, they will be payable from taxes on property or property ownership that are not subject to the limits of sections 11 and 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Summary 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect

If approved, this measure is expected to finance capital costs including building and site improvements, furnishing and equipping for the following projects:

- Preservation, seismic strengthening, security upgrades, remodeling, and replacement of building systems (such as heating, cooling, ventilation, plumbing, electrical, technology, and lighting) at Klamath Union High School, including improvements to core curriculum, arts, physical education spaces and vocational areas
- K-8 improvements targeting building security, student safety and building and site repair projects
- K-8 technology improvements and upgrades
- Bond issuance costs

Bonds would mature in a period not to exceed twenty-one (21) years from the date of issue and may be issued in one or more series. The District projects that the annual tax rate for bonds will be approximately \$1 per \$1,000 of assessed value during the first year, \$1.50 for the second year through year ten, and \$0.96 thereafter. Results may differ based upon actual interest rates incurred and growth in assessed value.
