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Final Ballot Title The following is the final ballot title of the measure to be submitted to the county's voters. The ballot title notice has been published and the ballot title challenge process has been completed.

Formation of the Klamath County Predatory Animal Control District

Shall the County form a district with a permanent rate limit of \$0.08 per \$1,000 assessed value beginning in 2016-2017?

If approved, the Klamath County Predatory animal Control District will, together with federal and state agencies, provide control of wild animals which adversely affect livestock, animal husbandry, populations of deer and elk, and which may threaten public health and safety; and will control mammals, rodents, and birds which may be destructive to agricultural crops and products or which may carry disease, in accordance with ORS 452.145. The district would provide funding and operate through a collective agreement with USDA, APHIS Wildlife Services, Oregon Department of Agriculture and Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to employ wildlife control personnel. The district would generally serve rural areas of Klamath County, excluding the City of Klamath Falls, territory within the urban growth boundary, and territory generally north of the old Oregon Military Crossing Road. The district would be funded by a permanent tax rate limit of \$0.08 per \$1,000 of assessed value beginning in 2016-2017 to provide support for the operations of predatory animal control. A home assessed at \$100,000 would pay approximately \$8 per year.
