

Should Bly Sanitary District and Bly Water District consolidate into one entity?

Summary 175 words

Bly Sanitary District and Bly Water District operate from the same facilities, have the same boards of trustees, employees and equipment, but operate as separate legal entities. Both districts have the same tax base and serve the same territory. Consolidation will not affect water rates, sewer rates, connection charges or terms of service. Consolidation will result in efficiencies of organization and eliminate duplicitous expense. The consolidated district will apply the permanent rate limits of each district: no increase in taxes will result.

Notice is hereby given that on November 6, 2012 a measure election will be held in the Crescent Rural Fire Protection District located in Klamath County, Oregon.

The following shall be the ballot title of the measure to be submitted to the district's voters:

CAPTION: 10 words

Five-Year Local Option Tax for Operations

QUESTION: 20 words

Shall the District levy \$.87 per \$1,000 for five years to provide fire and emergency medical services beginning FY 2013-2014? This measure may cause property taxes to increase more than three percent.

SUMMARY: 175 words

Crescent Rural Fire Protection District faces staff reductions without additional funds. The District's permanent tax rate is not enough to sustain services at its current level.

The last lay-off in 2009 affected advanced life support. The District received funding through a FEMA SAFER grant. Those funds will only last through 2014.

The proposed levy, if passed, will allow the District to continue its current level of services, including Advanced Life Support.

The proposed rate will raise approximately \$74,471 in 2013-2014; \$76,705 in 2014-2015; \$79,006 in 2015-2016; \$81,376 in 2016-2017; and \$83,817 in 2017-2018. The estimated tax cost for this measure is an ESTIMATE ONLY based on the best information available from the county assessor at the time of the estimate.
