The proposed rate will raise approximately, \$15,447 in 2012-2013, \$15,910 in 2013-2014, \$16,387 in 2014-2015 \$16,879 in 2015-2016, \$17,385 in 2016-2017, for a total of \$82,008.

Shall Klamath County support Klamath County Museum with 3-year levy of \$0.05 per \$1,000 assessed valuation beginning fiscal year 2011-2012? This measure may cause property taxes to increase more than three percent.

Summary 175 words

The Klamath County Museum System (Klamath County Museum, Baldwin Hotel and Fort Klamath) houses and preserves Klamath County's collection of historical documents, photos, books, maps and artifacts. The Museum provides public access for school field trips, individuals and families to view changing exhibits, and to research Klamath County's history. The Museum also provides educational programs.

Klamath County has eliminated all general fund funding to the Museum System. Without sufficient funds, all Klamath County Museum System property facilities will close to the public beginning in July 2011.


This measure enacts a three-year local option levy of \$0.05 per \$1,000 assessed property value to keep the Klamath County Museum System open to the public. It funds:

- Continuation of hours open to the public for all Klamath County Museum System properties;
- Free admission for all schoolchildren to regular Museum exhibits;
- Educational programs targeted at Klamath County schoolchildren to educate them about the service and sacrifice of local pioneers and veterans.

A home assessed by the County at \$150,000 pays \$7.50 per year for this levy.

The levy will raise an estimated \$215,000 for fiscal year 2011-2012; \$221,000 for fiscal year 2012-2013; and \$228,000 for fiscal year 2013-2014. Total amount raised will be \$664,000. The figures above are estimates only, based on the best information available from the County Assessor at the time of estimate.

Three-Year Local Option Tax for County Jail Operations

Question 20 words

Shall Klamath County impose \$.25 per \$1,000 assessed value for County jail operations for three years beginning 2011-2012? This measure may cause property taxes to increase more than three percent.

Klamath County will use the tax revenues from this measure to reopen and operate an additional 88 beds in the jail for the next three years. Currently, there is only one jail pod open with 64 beds. These additional revenues will restore the jail capacity to its maximum capacity of three pods with a total of 152 beds. These tax revenues will be used only for the jail, and not for any other purpose, and would not replace the County's funding for the first jail pod. The proposed rate will raise approximately \$1,182,884 in 2011-2012, \$1,206,541 in 2012-2013 (estimated 2% increase), and \$1,230,672 in 2013-2014 (estimated 2% increase), for a total of \$3,620,097. The figures above are estimates only, based on the best information available from the County Assessor at the time of estimate.
