Significant Changes 2012-2013

- **Personnel Changes:**
 - FY 2011-12 Budget Cuts were a layoff 4 full-time employees
 - Loss of Investigators for trial prep, criminal and child support investigations, locating and interviewing witnesses, subpoena service, and medical examiner case work
 - Caseload increase with less employees
 - Reduction in hours open to public
- **Budget for effective prosecution, case prioritization & court programs**

Significant Changes 2012-2013

- **Investigator/Medical Examiner**
 - **Maintaining Duties:** Investigating questionable deaths, obtaining medical records, prepare decedent body, autopsy assist, and RAIL report
 - **Reports impact Vital Statistics, Death Certificates, Families, Attorney's, Insurance Companies and Funeral Homes**
- **Domestic Violence Prosecutor**
 - **Specialized Prosecutor (Victim Safety/Offender Accountability)**
 - **Additional caseload for 5 remaining Deputy District Attorneys**
