Attached is the Tourism Grant Application from the Interstate Highlanders, Inc., District Council Of the Oregon Federation of Square and Round Dance Clubs. The PDF is bookmarked for ease of navigation.

History:

United States Congress designated square dance as the National Folk Dance, and is also the official dance of the State of Oregon.

The Oregon Federation of Square and Round Dance Clubs was organized in March of 1956, and now includes about 80 clubs from across the state of Oregon, the northern edge of California, and the southern edge of Washington. The purpose of the Federation is to promote the encouragement and enjoyment of square dancing and its associated activities such as Round Dance.

The Federation is financed through membership dues, and revenues from the two annual State Festivals. The Federation uses these funds to cover operational costs and to fund projects that will promote square dancing and related activities.

The Summer Festival is held annually, usually the 3rd weekend of July. Each of the 10 councils in Oregon is encouraged to host a Summer Festival. (The last time our area hosted a Summer Festival was 1978.)

Definition:

What is Square Dance? A **square dance is a dance for four couples** (eight dancers) arranged in a square, with one couple on each side, facing the middle of the square. The dancers are prompted or cued through a sequence of steps (square dance choreography) by a [caller](#) to the beat (and, in some traditions, the phrasing) of music.

What is Round Dance? A **unique and enjoyable form of couples dancing** which may be thought of as Ballroom Dancing to specific Choreography. Dancers are taught to lead or follow or both if desired. Singles may also enjoy learning the steps.

Why do it? **Dancing is an enjoyable and healthy way to exercise while making new friends.**

The Interstate Highlander Council, which includes Klamath and Lake Counties and Northern California-Alturas area, is hosting the Summer Festival July 17, 18, 19, 2015. In order to accomplish this goal we have booked the Klamath County Fairgrounds multi-purpose buildings 2 and 3.

However, we are a small not for profit organization with a pocket book to match. We don't know exactly how many dancers will attend this festival but hope to have at least 300 dancers.

We feel that with your assistance via the Tourism Grant Program we can effectively advertise this event to clubs around Oregon, California, Washington, Nevada and Idaho and make this a successful event for our area. Our goal is to have such a successful event that we can grow square and round dancing in our area and make this a regular event approximately every 3 to 5 years.

Oregon Federation of Square and Round Dance Clubs 2015 Summer Festival, a square and round dance festival. It will attract anywhere from 300 to 500 dancers, callers and cuers to Klamath County/Falls over a 4 day period July 16 to July 19, 2015.

The grant funds will be used to defray the cost of advertising/marketing this festival to dancers in Oregon, California, Washington, Nevada, and Idaho.

The main event is July 17-19, 2015. Our local square dance club, the Klamath Country Squares, is hosting a 'Trails End Dance' in Thursday, July 16, 2015.; We are also advertising the 2015 Diamond Lake Festival which begins on July 22. See Attached Flyers.

6. Describe your organization/project management team. How are these individuals qualified to lead this project? **The list of committee chairs is attached. Many of them have been involved in the planning of prior Festivals in this area as well as Oregon Federation Festivals.**

Our local club has been operating a two day festival in October for the past 37 years. Some years are more successful than others but we always have out of town guests who stay over night for the two day festival. This event is similar but on a more grand scale than the two day festival.

Our target market are square and round dancers all over Oregon and surrounding States.

See the attached list of flyers of past and proposed visitations and square dance challenge. Also Attached is a sample program book from a prior festival. We will publish and distribute a similar booklet for our Festival. It is in the process of development at this time. A copy will be provided in our final report.

We will measure the success by both the number of attendees and the net receipts.

12. Describe any in-kind, barter, volunteer labor or discounted services you expect to receive in support of this project. Volunteer labor hours will be valued at \$10.00 per hour for purposes of completing the budget form.

We are a not for profit organization and our committee is volunteer. The Oregon Federation Officers also are volunteers. Oregon Callers and Cuers volunteer their time to call and cue at the Festival.

13. List your potential sponsors and partners and how they contribute to the event or project.

The Oregon Federation sponsors two Festivals per year: The Mid-Winter in January and Summer Festival. Use of the Federation name on the event flyer identifies it as a Federation event for which Federated clubs, councils and dancers are expected to support.

14. If this is a regular recurring event or ongoing project, identify your marketing network and how it contributes to or enhances your success.

The Oregon Federation Summer Festival is an ongoing project in that the Federation sponsors the Summer Festival each year. However, Summer Festival hosting is by bid submission much like the Olympics. There are 10 councils who can submit a bid to the Federation for hosting the State Summer Festival. We are free to bid as much as we want but an event of this proportion takes a lot of work and much planning and so back to back hosting is not recommended. Also other Councils need to have the opportunity to host this event.
