The Festival overall was a success. Reports from dancer's were that it was the "Best Summer Festival" we have ever attended. Below is a copy of my report to the Oregon Federation:

We heard lots of praise from dancers that the dance program was wonderful. We have Roger Putzler, Tim Keck & Tammy Helms to thank for the dance program. We heard a lot of positive feedback on the youth activities. We have Lori McIntosh and her crew to thank for all the wonderful youth activities. We had a supper raffle and silent auction. There are so many people to thank it boggles my mind. We appreciate all the support we received. Delegates please alert your councils and area clubs that we thank them for their support. Of course we are grateful to the Federation Officers and Delegates also. I'm especially thankful to those of you who let me pick your brain when I was uncertain about specific segments of festival planning. We were frugal with our funds and sought partnerships and discounts where available. We also applied for grant money from the Klamath County Tourism grant funds. Without this money we would not have broken even. The council gained a lot of experience from this endeavor and feel that while monetarily it was not as successful as other festivals, it was a success overall.

The bulk of the grant dollars were spent on visitations to other areas club dances and festivals giving out details of our festival, our local information obtained from Discover Klamath and personal invitation. We also distributed our festival program books which were paid for by grant dollars.

5. What part of your marketing efforts were most successful and least successful? For infrastructure projects, what parts of your project were most successful and least successful?

The visitation and personal invitation method was the most successful even with the approximately 20% preregistrations we received.

We netted a total of 56 pre-registrations from visitations over the 2014-2015 period. That is not uncommon since most dancers wait until the last minute to spend their dollars. The distribution of program books is used by most major festivals as it is compact for dancers to carry but has all the major Festival information. This tool was very effective at getting dancers to pre-register in the final months leading up to the Festival.

6. How many people from out-of-county attended? 268 dancers, plus 48 callers, cuers and their spouses (316)

7. How did you determine how many people from out-of-county attended? Explain why this is an accurate Measurement of the out-of-county attendees.

8. How many extra days did your visitors stay in the area?

Approximately 40 dancers from out of the area arrived on 7/16 to attend pre-festival events such as our 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday demo downtown from 6-7pm and Trails End dance at Triad from 7:30 to 10:30. Some of these dancers also stayed around the area to attend the Diamond Lake Festival which started on July 22.

9. How did you determine how many extra days your visitors stayed? Explain why this is an accurate measurement of the extra days.

The 7/16 number is accurate from our sign in sheets from the trails end dance. We do not have a clear count as the Diamond Lake Festival is sponsored by a club in the Rogue SQ council so we don't have anything other than anecdotal evidence. Some of us attended the Diamond Lake Festival and noted there were many dancers that were seen at our Summer Festival.

We also distributed our festival program books which were paid for by grant dollars.**

5. What part of your marketing efforts were most successful and least successful? For infrastructure projects, what parts of your project were most successful and least successful?

**The visitation and personal invitation method was the most successful with the approximately 20% preregistrations we received.**

**We netted a total of 56 pre-registrations from visitations over the 2014-2015 period. That is not uncommon since most dancers wait until the last minute to spend their dollars. The distribution of program books is used by most major festivals as it is compact for dancers to carry but has all the major Festival information. This tool was very effective at getting dancers to pre-register in the final months leading up to the Festival.**

6. How many people from out-of-county attended? **268 dancers, plus 48 callers, cuers and their spouses (316)**

7. How did you determine how many people from out-of-county attended? Explain why this is an accurate Measurement of the out-of-county attendees.

**By Use of Pre-Registration Forms and sign in sheets for last minute attendees. See the registration excel sheet on the digital documentation CD and copies of registration and sign sheets.**

8. How many extra days did your visitors stay in the area?

**Approximately 36 dancers and 6 callers, cuers and their spouses from out of the area arrived on 7/16 to attend pre-festival events such as our 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday demo downtown from 6-7pm and Trails End dance at Triad from 7:30 to 10:30. Some of these dancers also stayed around the area to attend the Diamond Lake Festival which started on July 22.**

9. How did you determine how many extra days your visitors stayed? Explain why this is an accurate Measurement of the extra days.

**The 7/16 number is accurate from our sign in sheets from the trails end dance. We do not have a clear count as the Diamond Lake Festival is sponsored by a club in the Rogue SQ council so we don't have anything other than anecdotal evidence. Some of us attended the Diamond Lake Festival and noted there were many dancers that were seen at our Summer Festival.**







2015 Summer Festival Chair Report:

Our after party at the 2014 Summer Festival on June 20 was a success.

We have a total of 36 pre-registrations:

3-Pre-paid prior to the 2014 Summer Festival (Dale & Kathy Worthington and Cece Glidewell)

At 2014 Summer Festival:

11-OFSRDC officers, delegates and spouses

3-KC and or Council members (Denny Fullerton, Doty DeGarmo and Sandy Marks)

3-youth dancers (Lorri McIntosh's grandchildren-Grant's Pass, OR)

16-adult dancers

33 total

The 16 adult pre-registrations will be entered into the drawing for the free ribbon as advertised: (The 2015 Summer Festival committee is offering a reduced registration price at our 2014 Summer Festival "After Party" on June 20 in Prineville. Any dancer who pre-registers at the 2014 Summer Festival will only have to pay \$30 per person which is a \$10 savings off the pre-registration price. Those pre-registered dancers also will be entered into a special drawing in which one lucky person will get their registration fee returned at the 2015 Summer Festival on Saturday, July 18, 2015 at the "Awards" presentation. The dancer must be present to win of course and the refund will be the \$30 "after party" pre-registration fee paid on June 20, 2014.) We got several compliments on the refreshments that Adana put together for the after party. Our vests and T-shirts were also well received.

I have given Adana \$950 for deposit into the 2015 Summer Festival account (\$470 in checks and \$480 cash) for the pre-registrations which includes \$50 for RV parking. (FYI \$90 was already deposited which were Dale and Kathy Worthington and Cece Glidewells's pre-registrations)

I will forward copies of the RV pre-registrations to the Wagon Masters, John & Glory Gutches, so they can use them to plan the RV parking.

Vendor Update:

Bob Bosch of Sq-Dini Badges pre-paid his vendor registration at \$130.50 for a 10x15 spot and 1/3 page ad in the program book. His payment was given to Adana Young to deposit into our Summer Festival Account.

Designs by Keith has expressed an interest in vending at our Festival. I had previously sent him a copy of the vendor contract. I will take hard copy to the Central Oregon Round Up as he said he will be there this year.

I also have a list of other vendors to contact. The clothing vendors I have contacted have declined to commit to date. I will keep on it as I think having clothing/shoe vendors is important for our festival.

Follow-up after 2014 Summer Festival

Roger Putzler emailed his Vendor Contract for his Jewelry booth. He has requested a 10x20 spot with 5 tables and 2 chairs a \$200 value. He is proposing that we trade this for his calling the

Trails End dance on Thursday, July 16, 2015. He also requested a 1/3 page ad in the program book which is \$18 per the fee schedule. (The total is \$298 including the two festival ribbons. (\$80+200+18). We will need to decide if this arrangement is acceptable so I can get back to him with our decision. As you know Roger is also the caller coordinator for the Festival.

I also received Christina Corelli's signed contract for \$75 for cuing the Trails End Dance.

I will be getting the flyer for the Trails End Dance prepared and posted on our website as well as hard copies for distribution throughout the State.

Tammy Helms and Tim Keck have agreed to help us with the cueing program for the festival. I also asked for their help with the Showcase of Rounds. However, 2015 Mid-Winter asked that we not contact callers and cuers until they have their schedule set-approx late August.

The Youth Committee Chair, Lorri McIntosh and I will be getting together on July 12 to plan some youth activities for our Festival. We hope to have a bowling and pizza party on Friday night. We have already approached the director of the Klamath Falls Saturday Market, Charlie Wyckoff, and asked to do a demo from 10 to 12 on Saturday for the youth and young at heart. In the works will be a trip to the Klamath County Museum after the demo at the farmer's market. We will prepare a budget for the youth activities and my plan is to include the cost in my next grant request this Fall. Lorri McIntosh will obtain a caller for the youth activities. Sarge and I will use our connections at ORDTA to get a cuer for the youth activities.

We have used the majority of our \$1,667 from Klamath County to pay for expenses. We have around \$300 left. Any outstanding expenses such as the receipts for the refreshments at the 2014 Summer Festival need to be given to me so I can submit them for re-imbursement. I too need to get all expenses finalized so I can prepare the report for Klamath County per our grant request agreement.

Roxanne Sprout has delivered letters to the local motels announcing our event and giving them the opportunity to advertise in our program book. We will be following up in the next few weeks. We will also be contacting local eating establishments offering the same deal in our program book.

I stopped in this week and talked to Dawn, the events coordinator for the Klamath County Fairgrounds. Our event is still on their books, even with the staffing change. After the 2014 Fair is over she will be preparing our contract and will send that out for our signature. She said the new director will honor our verbal agreement made last year.

And when you arrive in Klamath, please stop by our Welcome Center to say hello.



## Featured Caller



SCOT BYARS

Scot started dancing in 1965 in the San Francisco Bay area when his parents dropped him off at the local pre-teen club for one night of peace and quiet each week. Soon he was a member of the Spottighters, an exhibition group for pre-teens. In 1970, at age 11, Scot accepted a challenge from his partner to do a better job than she could on a singing call, and he was hooked. Soon his dad was driving him three hours each way on Wednesday evenings to call for the Konocti Kickers in the town of Clearlake. Before long he was also club caller for the Fairfield Barnstormers (a teen club), Rancho Rascals of San Pablo (the pre-teen club where he started), and the Huffs and Puffs of San Rafael, an adult club with a regular weekly attendance of 25 squares. Scot estimates he has taught over 3000 people to square dance! Between moves up, down, then up, the state of California, he has always taught new dancers as well as calling festivals, hoedowns, parties, and intro nights. He is a pioneer of the Blast Class format, and has been a full-time caller since 2003.

In March of 2015, Scot earned the title of CALLERLAB Accredited Caller Coach. To accomplish this, he completed a rigorous training and testing process which takes several years. He was also recently re-elected to the Board of Governors of CALLERLAB.

Currently, Scot travels all over California, and visits Virginia, Oregon, Colorado, Nevada, Arizona, Idaho and Alaska doing both dances and festivals. He calls each week for five clubs in Sacramento, Solano, Placer, and El Dorado counties. He is well-known for his exceptional singing voice and extremely upbeat and enthusiastic style.

## FEATURED CUER



Erin Byars

Erin began square dancing in 1969 and round dancing in 1972. In 1974 she was asked to join the Silhouettes, a premiere teen round dance exhibition group under the direction of Betty & Bob Dean. During that time she would often dance with Bob and he would say, "Cue along with Betty." When she asked why, she was told, "Don't ask questions, just do as I say!" By the age of 18 she was cueing dances for local clubs.

Between 1978 and 1985, Erin took some time off from cueing, but not dancing. In 1985 She and Scot became a team and he encouraged her to begin cueing and teaching again. She has been featured round dance instructor at festivals in Alaska, California, Oregon, and Idaho.

Erin & Scot have choreographed several popular dances including

"Shake It for Me" (CH IV),

"One Less Set of Footsteps" (TS II),

"Daydream Believer" (FT III),

"Time in a Bottle" (WZ III),

"You Light the Skies" (STS IV),

"I Only Want You for Christmas" (TS II),

"Last Words of a Fool" (WZ II)

and -- a recent hit at the National Square Dance Convention in Oklahoma City --

"Caramel" (RB IV).

Many of these dances have become "Rounds of the Month/Quarter" not only in Northern and Southern California, but in Colorado, Washington, and Wisconsin!

Cueing through phase 4, and following in Betty's footsteps, Erin believes her job is to help people love round dancing.

## Featured Caller



SCOT BYARS

Scot started dancing in 1965 in the San Francisco Bay area when his parents dropped him off at the local pre-teen club for one night of peace and quiet each week. Soon he was a member of the Spotlighters, an exhibition group for pre-teens. In 1970, at age 11, Scot accepted a challenge from his partner to do a better job than she could on a singing call, and he was hooked. Soon his dad was driving him three hours each way on Wednesday evenings to call for the Konocti Kickers in the town of Clearlake. Before long he was also club caller for the Fairfield Barnstormers (a teen club), Rancho Rascals of San Pablo (the pre-teen club where he started), and the Huffs and Puffs of San Rafael, an adult club with a regular weekly attendance of 25 squares. Scot estimates he has taught over 3000 people to square dance! Between moves up, down, then up, the state of California, he has always taught new dancers as well as calling festivals, hoedowns, parties, and intro nights. He is a pioneer of the Blast Class format, and has been a full-time caller since 2003.

In March of 2015, Scot earned the title of CALLERLAB Accredited Caller Coach. To accomplish this, he completed a rigorous training and testing process which takes several years. He was also recently re-elected to the Board of Governors of CALLERLAB.

Currently, Scot travels all over California, and visits Virginia, Oregon, Colorado, Nevada, Arizona, Idaho and Alaska doing both dances and festivals. He calls each week for five clubs in Sacramento, Solano, Placer, and El Dorado counties. He is well-known for his exceptional singing voice and extremely upbeat and enthusiastic style.

## About the Federation

The Oregon Federation of Square and Round Dance Clubs was organized in March of 1956, and now includes about 80 clubs from across the state of Oregon, the northern edge of California, and the southern edge of Washington. The purpose of the Federation is to promote the encouragement and enjoyment of square dancing and its associated activities.

The Federation holds five meetings annually, one each at the Mid-Winter and Summer Festivals, and three others rotating through the 13 area councils. All meetings are open, and dancers are encouraged to attend.

The Federation is financed through membership dues, and revenues from the two annual State Festivals. The Federation uses these funds to cover operational costs and to fund projects that will promote square dancing.

The Federation was instrumental in having the United States Congress designate the square dance as the National Folk Dance, and in having square dancing named as the official dance of the State of Oregon. Oregon hosted more than 22,000 dancers from around the world at the 43rd National Square Dance Convention® in Portland in June, 1994, still the second largest convention ever held at the Oregon Convention Center. We repeated this privilege in June, 2005, when more than 8,000 dancers showed up for the 54th National Square Dance Convention®.

These accomplishments and the hosting of numerous benefit dances has placed the Oregon Federation of Square and Round Dance Clubs as one of the leaders in the community. The dancers of Oregon should be proud of what their Federation has been able to accomplish.
