

**Public Notice**  
**Klamath County Contracts for FY 2011-2012**

Pursuant to ORS 210.210(8), Klamath County is publishing all contracts entered into for fiscal year 2011-12. IGAs (IGA) do not require bonds or public bids. Public Improvement projects exceeding \$50,000 may require performance and payment bonds, as well as a public works bond. Private contractors are printed in italics.
