

## **Prohibited Materials**

The Klamath County Ordinance number 406.005 (21) defines prohibited materials as:

“Any combustible material as defined by the State’s prohibited materials open burning rule which include garbage, plastic, wire insulation, automobile parts, asphalt, petroleum products, any petroleum treated material, rubber products, animal remains, or animal or vegetable matter resulting from the handling, preparation, cooking or service of food that normally results in dense or noxious smoke when burned. Also included are any open burned materials that cause a public or private nuisance or a hazard to public safety.”

Remove all prohibited materials before burning. Many of the materials that are prohibited from being burned may be disposed of in the landfill. Please check with the Klamath County Community Development Solid Waste Division at 883-5121 if you have any questions.
