4. Amie McAuliffe, Lost River Community Center - Project Update And Request For Letter Of Support

Amie McAuliffe addresses the Board with update related to the Community Center project and request for letter of support. Commissioner DeGroot motions to sign letter of support, Commissioner Boyd seconds. Commissioner Morris states that the County will keep them apprised of funding as it comes available. Unanimous vote. 5. Greg Davis, Fire Chief Fire District 1 - Unprotected Areas & American Recovery Act

Chief Davis, Chief Brown and Chief Hitchcock address the Board present a map of current boundaries and areas immediately surrounding the district that they would like to annex into the district. Commissioner Morris questions the process, Davis explains. Commissioner Boyd explains that Fire District #3 just annexed in a large area. Further discussion that the County and the Fire District are both supportive of growth and business development, would like to work with the County on future growth and tax abatement decisions. Board asks for the District to keep them posted as they move through this annexation process.



Additionally, wildfire season is coming and is not looking good, the district works closely with ODF. Presents list of available staffing within the District, ODF and BLM explain the roles. Commissioner DeGroot is very concerned about the upcoming season are there specific area of concern? Chief Davis responds, they have many area that are of concerns, but difficult to identify a few. Commissioner DeGroot asks for them to notify Commissioner staff if they can identify some and perhaps the County can get some dollars to the District to mitigate those areas. Commissioner Morris suggests getting Brandon Fowler involved.
