Commissioner DeGroot - It's so nice to see everybody in the audience today. It's valuable to hear from you, we appreciate you coming in. I heard it was thought we would talking about how we are handling the mandates today. That was discussed last week. The minutes are available. I met with the head of the local group that joined a lawsuit with other organizations throughout the State to push back against the mandates and I let him know he had my support. As this is the right way, it needs to be litigated in the courts.

Commissioner Morris - I was pleasantly surprised to see a full room today. There was no decision making by this body on the mandates. As everyone here is well versed and knows, this is a State mandate not a County mandate. I appreciate hearing the feedback today. It's great to hear from you. I've been working on getting resources to people who have dry and failing wells. The effort was a partnership with the State and County, but the bulk of the work was done by volunteers. I want to publicly thank our Citizen Emergency Response Team and the members of our local churches.
