

# Klamath County Public Health

## Restrictions on the use of fireplaces, woodstoves, wood-burning fireplace inserts and pellet stoves within Klamath County for the 2018-19 heating season

Starting October 15, 2018, and ending March 15, 2019, Klamath County Public Health will provide a daily air quality advisory for the use of fireplaces and woodstoves within the air quality zone. The advisory will give:

- Specific restrictions on the use of fireplaces, woodstoves, fireplace inserts and pellet stoves within the Air Quality Zone;
- Restrictions on outside or open burning countywide; and
- The EPA Air Quality Index for the past 24 hours.

### Fireplace, woodstove and wood-burning fireplace insert restrictions within the air quality zone

Advisory	Allowed to use	Prohibited
<b>Green</b>	Fireplaces, non-certified woodstoves, non-certified fireplace inserts, certified woodstoves, certified fireplace inserts, and pellet stoves.	Burning Trash
<b>Yellow</b>	Certified woodstoves, certified fireplace inserts, pellet stoves.	Fireplaces, non-certified woodstoves, non-certified fireplace inserts, trash, and outdoor burning.
<b>Red</b>	Pellet stoves	Fireplaces, non-certified woodstoves, non-certified fireplace inserts, certified woodstoves, certified fireplace inserts, trash, and outdoor burning.
<b>Health Alert</b>	Pellet Stoves	All Wood Burning Appliances
Open or outdoor burning is prohibited within the air quality zone <u>except</u> during the Spring and Fall open burning windows.		

### Fireplace, woodstove and wood-burning fireplace insert restrictions outside the air quality zone

Advisory	Allowed to use
<b>Green</b>	Fireplaces, non-certified woodstoves, or non-certified fireplace inserts, certified woodstoves or certified fireplace inserts, pellet stoves.
<b>Yellow</b>	
<b>Red</b>	
Open or outdoor burning is allowed outside the air quality zone except during Yellow or Red advisories. (Prohibited materials: plastic, rubber products, garbage and treated wood.)
