Home and telephone visits

Visits were conducted through the Babies First and CaCoon programs. A public health nurse makes home visits to provide services to children who are at risk for poor health outcomes.

Babies First! is a home visiting program for newborn children up to five years old. Public Health nurses regularly work closely with family doctors and clinics to monitor growth and development.

CaCoon is a care coordination program for families that have children with special health needs. CaCoon's goal is to help families learn new skills to become as independent as possible in caring for the child. The program is a cooperative effort between families and health care providers.
